BETTY PRICE KEY NOTE SPEAKER AT HONOR SOCIETY INDUCTION AT ROSWELL HIGH SCHOOL

ROSWELL, GA. October 7, 2009 – The Roswell High School inducted sixty five new members into the National Honor Society on Wednesday, October 6th at the Roswell High School auditorium. Family and friends gathered to celebrate those students who were entered into the book of past inductees as part of a traditional candlelight ceremony.
