ROSWELL COUNCIL CANDIDATE BETTY PRICE SPEAKS AT TAX RALLY SEND OFF IN ROSWELL

ROSWELL, GA. September 14, 2009 – Dr. Betty Price addressed the gathering at the Taxpayer March on D.C. Rendezvous Rally held in Roswell prior to the momentous event this past weekend at the Washington D.C. mall. Killer Creek Harley-Davidson in Roswell hosted the assembly as a stop off point for riders who had come from various points in the southeast, including motorcyclists with the Sons of Liberty from Tallahassee, Florida. Hundreds of attendees came to support and send off those riders who were on their way to the nation's capital to protest the federal government's handling of many issues in recent months. The speakers included gubernatorial candidates, who charged up the crowd and voiced their appreciation for the many patriots among the attendees. Dr. Price spoke passionately about the health care debate, which has garnered the attention of grass roots activists of all political viewpoints. Price explained, "What you aren't hearing about are the alternative health care proposals that are out there." She went on to describe the specifics of H.R. 3400, a common sense plan that has been put on the table by a large conservative caucus, chaired by husband Congressman Tom Price of Roswell. At the same time Congressman Price was speaking to hundreds of thousands of protestors at the Capitol in Washington on Saturday, Betty shared the stage with radio personality Herman Cain at North Fulton and Friends' "TEA Party" held at Roswell City Hall.
